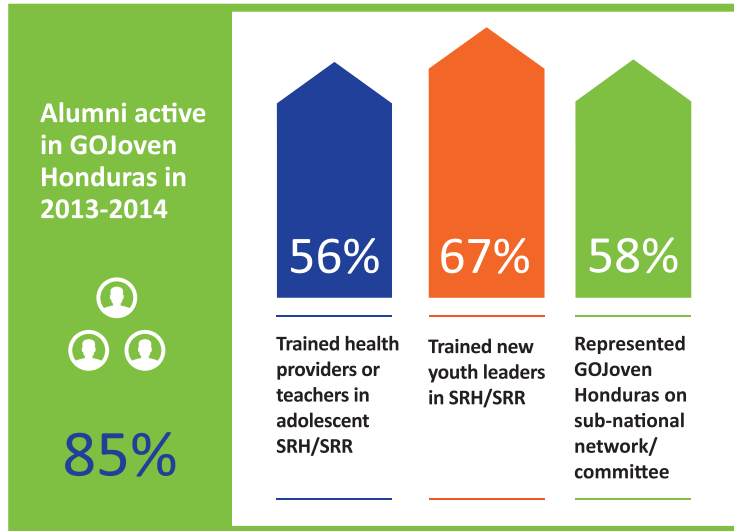
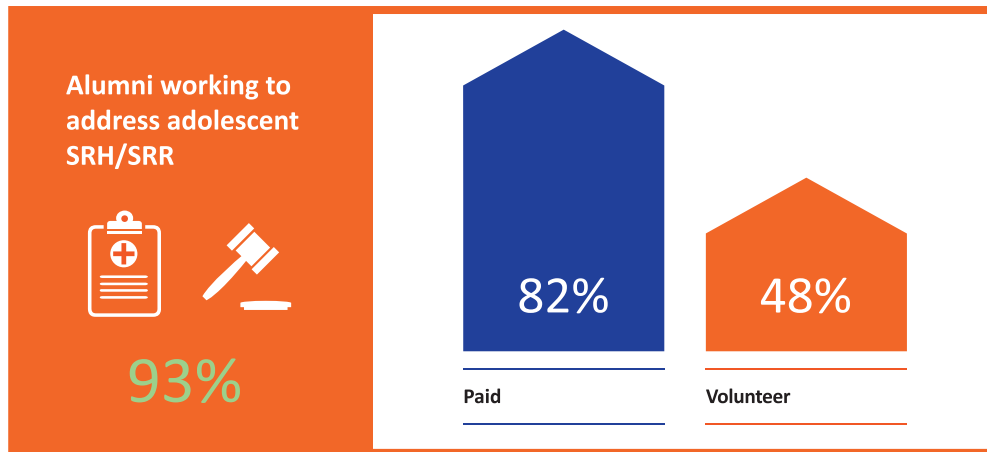


From 2004 to 2012, the GOJoven Youth Leadership in Sexual and Reproductive Health Program of the Public Health Institute (USA) trained nine cohorts of Fellows in Honduras, totaling 41 young people. In 2013, GOJoven alumni in Honduras established the NGO GOJoven Honduras to promote comprehensive adolescent development through the strengthening of policy advocacy capacities and processes, with a focus on ensuring compliance with sexual and reproductive rights (SRR) and improving sexual and reproductive health (SRH). In 2015, 27 GOJoven alumni in Honduras responded to a survey (sent to 38 alumni) on participation in GOJoven Honduras, relevant work, and leadership.¹

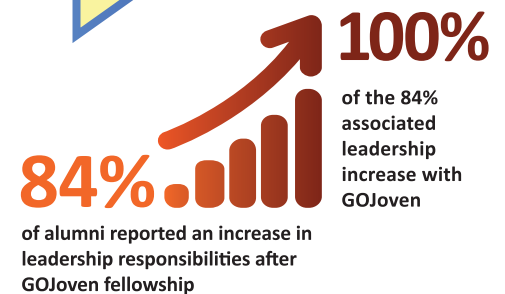
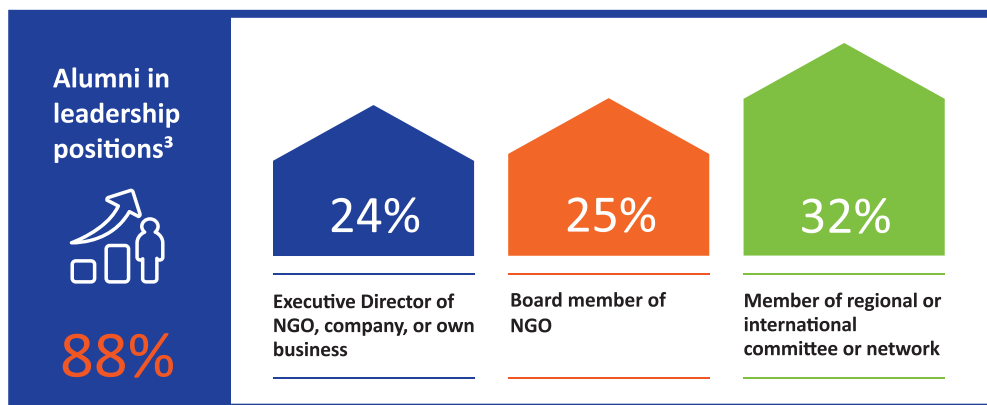


Alumni Active in GOJoven Honduras in 2013-2014, by Department, per 2015 Alumni Survey²
